

SERMON NOTES 🚺 JAN 7, 2024

I Will Build My Church Matthew 16:13-20 Dr. Tony Chute, Lead Pastor

Overview: The conversation between Jesus and the disciples at Caesarea Philippi contains the first reference to the church in the Bible and stipulates that the church will outlast all other human institutions. When asked who people think Jesus really is, Peter responds by elevating Jesus above all other teachers and prophets, specifically calling Him the Messiah, the Son of the living God. The fact that Peter has not reached this conclusion simply by his own intuition indicates the reality of the new birth as a gift from heaven; the fact that Jesus says He will build His church indicates that those who confess Jesus as the Son of God now belong to something larger than themselves. The keys of the kingdom and the act of binding and loosing represent the church's responsibility to invite people to Christ while maintaining the standards set forth by Christ. Faithfulness in this regard will arouse opposition against the church, but Jesus promises the disciples, and us, that the church will prevail.

01. Jesus founded the church; therefore, the church belongs to Jesus. Let us view the church from His perspective, and let us love the church with His love.

02. Those who belong to Jesus belong to the church. Let us unite with the church and serve the church as an act of devotion to Jesus.

03. The church is both a taste of heaven and a test for heaven. Let us remember that the church will face opposition, but the church is everlasting.

QUESTIONS FOR DISCUSSION & DISCOVERY

1. How would you define the church? Is it a building, a local establishment, a fellowship, a family, or what? What biblical texts indicate the importance of the church to Jesus? How important is the church to you? In what ways is the significance of the church evident in your life?

2. What is the significance of Peter's confession in v. 16? What other options were being offered at the time? How does Jesus' response to Peter set forth the foundation of the church? Can a church really be a church without confessing Jesus as the Son of God?


3. What does Jesus mean when He tells Peter, "Flesh and blood has not revealed this to you, but my Father who is in Heaven"? In what way does this statement indicate the importance of the new birth for understanding who Jesus is and appreciating the church that He founded? How did your understanding and appreciation of the church change after you became a Christian?

4. If the keys of the kingdom are not literal, what do they represent? In what way do Peter and the other disciples open the door for people to enter the kingdom? What is mistaken about the notion that the church is open for everybody? Put another way, how should believers welcome non-believers to church while maintaining standards of belief and behavior in the church?

5. Do you find hope in the fact that Jesus promises His church will withstand the gates of hell? What does this statement assume about ongoing and increased opposition to the church? How has Northpoint helped you live faithfully in a world that is opposed to the things of God? How are you helping others to grow in the Lord as a member of Northpoint?
