## Dear Friends,

Our annual Sale has long been an opportunity for members of the community to come together to work on a joint project. In regular years, we throw open our doors to welcome in people from the neighbourhood. This year, we aim to hold the sale in a slightly different way to keep everyone safe as the pandemic continues. But it is still a way to access locally made goods, repurpose treasures and second-hand items, and raise funds for vital ministries in the parish. Our parish is committed to outreach work. Since 2015, we have helped to welcome four refugee sponsorships. Every week, we connect with community organizations to support food security efforts with Flemingdon Food Bank. And we seek to connect with our neighbours, offering a monthly coffee house, sponsoring events like Halloween and Blessing of the Bikes, and welcoming children for PA Day programming. In addition to being home to engaging and inclusive worship, our facilities welcome and support community groups in the neighbourhood. This fundraiser supports our ministry efforts and we thank you for your ongoing support and flexibility as we try out a new model.
