LOVING GOD - LOVING ONE ANOTHER - REACHING HIS WORLD

SERMON NOTES 🚺 NOV 27, 2022

We Ask You and We Urge You 1 Thessalonians 5:12-15 Dr. Tony Chute, Lead Pastor

Overview: As Paul closes out his letter to the Thessalonians, he addresses interpersonal relationships within the church. He addresses them as brothers, an all-inclusive term that reminds them of their unity in Christ, and he directs their attention to those who are above them and those who seem to be beneath them. The first category refers to leadership in the church and thus reflects a divinely ordained structure; the second category refers to membership in the church and thus reflects ongoing needs among the body. Paul asks the Thessalonians to respect the leaders of the church by recognizing their position, heeding their admonition, and esteeming them very highly in love because of their work. He then urges them to care for those who are struggling in the church by admonishing the idle, encouraging the fainthearted, helping the weak, and being patient in the process. Such reminders presuppose the potential for conflict in the church, but the goal is for Christians to be at peace with one another, which can be achieved by doing good to one another and to everyone.

01. Pray for the leaders of Northpoint to be worthy of the calling we have and the office we hold so we can earn the respect and esteem of each of you.

02. Pray for the members of Northpoint to be mindful of those who struggle in various ways in the church so we can demonstrate the love of Christ to all.

STANDING FAST IN THE LORD

QUESTIONS FOR DISCUSSION & DISCOVERY

1. What offices of the church does Paul have in mind in verses 12-13? Does Paul expect people to esteem the office only or the person who occupies that office as well? Hint: See the qualifications Paul lists in 1 Timothy 3:1-7 and Titus 1:5-9 for additional insight. In what ways do you find such character traits to be relevant to the work of pastors and elders? What dangers would occur if such character traits were deficient in spiritual leadership?

2. What does Ephesians 4:11-16 state about the divinely ordained structure of leadership in the church? What is the primary function of leaders in relation to building up the church? Is such building up primarily spiritual growth or numerical growth? How can leaders and members work together to ensure that each member is "working properly" by contributing to the building up of the body? Do you feel encouraged to use your gifts in the church for the building up of the body?

3. What types of labor and work do pastors and elders do in addition to preaching, teaching, praying, member care, outreach, planning, organizing, counseling, problem solving, etc.? What areas of work and labor do you feel are the most demanding for pastors and elders? How can you pray for leaders in the church to be more effective, dedicated, and focused on their work for the church?

4. Note the various issues Paul cites in the membership of the church: the idle, the fainthearted, and the weak. Does this sound like a healthy church to you? Can you imagine any church without such issues? Note how Paul includes all members of the church as potential solutions to the problems of the church. What is his solution for each situation? Are you able to help such people to recover their joy in the Lord?

5. Why does Paul encourage the Thessalonians to "be patient with them all"? Do you find it easier to dismiss those who are struggling than to work with them? How does our impatience with others signify a lack of Christian love? Would you say that Jesus has been patient with you? See 1 Corinthians 13:4.
