

Animal Exposure Assessment Instructions

Part I. Personal Identification

Provide your first and last name, department, ten-digit USC ID #, job title, and work and home/mobile phone numbers. Provide your supervisor's name, title and work phone number. Check the box that identifies your current research status.

Before proceeding to the rest of the survey you will need to choose whether to opt in or opt out.

Opting Out:

If you choose to opt out, please note that you can opt in at any time later.

Part II. Past Medical History

- Your personal medical history: Check the boxes of any of the following conditions you have had. Write an explanation for all the items you checked.
- Smoking History: Indicate your history of smoking.
- **Allergy History:** List any animal allergies you have acquired in the past indicating the year in which you became aware of that allergy. List the type of reaction you have with that allergy.
 - List any laboratory animal that you were exposed to in a former job. Include the animal species, length of exposure, and the type of exposure for each animal listed.
- **Review of Systems:** Check any of the following symptoms or changes you have experienced recently. Explain the nature of any items you have marked.
- **Medications:** List any long-term medications you are currently taking including both prescribed and over-the- counter medications. Include the name and dosage. List any known allergies you may have to medication. List any other allergies you may have. Check whether you would like to discuss any of your answers with the physician who reviewed your survey.

Part III. Animal Exposure

Select all laboratory animals that you are currently exposed to. Select the duties listed that describe the nature of your work with the laboratory animals. Select your anticipated level of exposure to the laboratory animals. Select the types of personal protective equipment (PPE) you use when working with the laboratory animals.

Answer yes or no to any of the following changes you may have experienced. For all instances where you mark yes, explain the nature of the changes or symptoms, you have experienced.

Please choose "Yes" or "No" if you give approval for release of your animal exposure risk assessment status to your employer in order to initiate protective measures if needed. If this question remains unanswered, it is considered as opting out.
