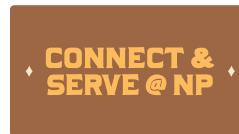

Not Everyone ... And Everyone

Matthew 7:21-27

Overview: The concluding words in the Sermon on the Mount make clear that Jesus is the only one who grants or denies access to heaven. There is a fixed day appointed for all people to give an account of their lives, and the judgment rendered is in accordance with the will of God, not individual whims or societal expectations. Although Jesus provides salvation for all who truly come to Him by repentance and faith, many will still cling to alternatives in hopes of establishing their worthiness to enter the kingdom. The “many” who attempt to do so include those who rely on the veneer of Christian service to make their case, but they will be definitively denied due to their lack of genuine conversion. Jesus thus calls all people to trust Him by hearing His words and putting them into practice. Those who fail to do so are regarded as fools who will find their world crashing down.

01. Biblical Christianity affirms that Jesus alone is the Savior of the world; nominal Christianity relies on other false alternatives.

02. Biblical Christianity clings to Jesus alone as the source of salvation; nominal Christianity substitutes human effort instead.

03. Biblical Christianity withstands the onslaught of the world; nominal Christianity collapses in the face of opposition.

Not Everyone ... And Everyone

1. What examples from this text indicate that Jesus is the only one who grants or denies access to heaven? What examples from other texts support this claim? What would you say to others who believe that there are many ways to heaven apart from Jesus? See John 14:6 for further insight.

2. Jesus says, “Not everyone who says to me ‘Lord, Lord’ will enter the kingdom of heaven.” On what basis will such people be rejected? What does it mean to be a “worker of lawlessness”? Does this refer to occasional sins which we regret and repent from, or does it refer to habitual sins that we neither regret nor repent from? See 1 John 2:1-6 for further insight.

3. In what ways do professed Christians sometimes rely on the performance of religious duties as a substitute for genuine repentance from sin and faith in Christ? What is the role of good works in the Christian life? Do they produce or flow from our salvation? See James 2:14-26 for further insight.

3. As you envision yourself standing before the Lord on that day, what will you say to Jesus as reason why you should enter heaven? Are you confident that the work of Christ has fully satisfied the requirements of the law and that His death on the cross has fully paid the price for your sins? See Luke 23:39-43 for further insight.

4. What hope against opposition and tragedy does Jesus offer to those who hear His words and put them into practice? Have you ever felt your world come crashing down only to discover that the foundation beneath is solid as ever? Take a moment to thank the Lord for being so reliable in times of difficulty.
