# **SERMON NOTES**



NOV 20, 2022

### The Day of the Lord

1 Thessalonians 5:1-11 Dr. Tony Chute, Lead Pastor

**Overview:** Paul continues to comfort the Thessalonians as they mourn their deceased loved ones and face the possibility of ongoing persecution. Instead of offering a timeline of end-time events, Paul reminds them of what he has already taught regarding the day of the Lord. It is a day that will come as a surprise to those who are living for this world alone, whereupon their sense of security will be interrupted by the inescapable reality of God's judgment. Paul then reassures the Thessalonians that their future is considerably more promising: they are not children of darkness, but children of light; they are not destined for wrath, but will obtain salvation through the Lord Jesus Christ. Such knowledge of God's favor should spur us, as it did the Thessalonians, to look and long for the Lord's return as we live faithfully for Him in this world.

01. For the unbelieving world, the day of the Lord is a day of judgment that will come suddenly with no hope of escape. Prepare for this day now by finding your peace and security in Jesus Christ.

02. For the suffering church, the day of the Lord is a day of hope that will bring salvation. Prepare for this day now by living in the light, remaining active in the world, and longing for the return of Jesus Christ.

# QUESTIONS FOR DISCUSSION & DISCOVERY

- 1. What is the day of the Lord? How does the Old Testament present this day as a day of judgment for unbelievers? See Isaiah 13:9, Jeremiah 14:6, Ezekiel 30:3, and Obadiah 15-20 for examples. How does God's pending judgment on the unbelieving world foster your attempts to evangelize others and promote missions?
- 2. Why does Paul decline to write about the times and seasons with regard to the day of the Lord? What does the Bible teach about the times and seasons in other passages? See Daniel 7 and Matthew 24 for examples. Which of the following excites you more: discussions about end times, including timelines, charts, and maps—or discussions about holy living in light of the second coming of Jesus?
- 3. How does Amos 5:18-20 warn God's people against becoming complacent in light of the day of the Lord? What are some ways that Christians can become complacent regarding the day of the Lord? How does Paul's admonition in verses 6-8 help us to fight against complacency?
- 4. How does Paul contrast believers and unbelievers in this passage? Note the use of surprise and comfort, judgment and salvation, and complacency and expectation. How does your life reflect a biblical longing for the Lord's return with regard to living by faith, hope, and love?
- 5. Paul closes this passage with words of comfort, just as he did in 1 Thessalonians 4:18. How can you use these passages to comfort one another during times of suffering, grief, and difficulty? Pray that the Lord will help us encourage and comfort one another with a biblical understanding of the Lord's return.
