Such a Thing Must Not Be Done

Genesis 34 Dr. Tony Chute, Lead Pastor

Overview: Dinah's excursion to see the women of Shechem made her vulnerable to attack, resulting in her being violently assaulted and defiled. The perpetrator desired to marry her and asked for his father, Hamor, to arrange the marriage with her father, Jacob. When the sons of Jacob discovered what happened to Dinah, they were rightly incensed and concocted a plan to defend her honor. They arranged an agreement to allow intermarriages between their tribes and the people of Shechem upon the condition that the latter undergo circumcision. After the rite had been performed, Simeon and Levi began a killing spree and plundered the city. Although they rescued Dinah and defended her honor, their tactics resulted in far more violence than was acceptable at the time and placed future generations of their own families at risk. So many of these events could have been prevented, but the account gives no indication of a responsible party taking charge; therefore, we are left to ask how to prevent such occurrences and how to rightly right a wrong.

01. The assault on Dinah represents a misconstrual of men's relationship to women. Though dominant physically, men are called to be respectful of women, appropriately tender towards women, and protective of women.

02. The violence toward the men of Shechem represents a misconstrual of justice but points to justice nonetheless. Therefore, men should lead with purity, confront sexual immorality, and act decisively when addressing harm toward women.

QUESTIONS FOR DISCUSSION & DISCOVERY

- 1. Why was Jacob's family in Shechem rather than Bethel (see Genesis 33)? How might this episode have been different if Jacob had gone to Bethel as he previously committed? How might this episode have been different if Dinah had her brothers with her during her journey?
- 2. Note the violent terminology of Shechem's actions in verse 2, followed by his tender affection in verse 3. What accounts for his change of heart toward Dinah? How much better would this episode have been if his tender feelings prevented him from assaulting Dinah? What can we learn from this story to help clarify the importance of self-control and purity in relationships?
- 3. How does Shechem's standing in his community contribute to his actions towards Dinah and lead to the downfall of his community? What lessons can we learn about influential people who are morally inept? How do such people bring disaster upon a community or nation? What do you value more in yourself or others—economic standing, celebrity status, or moral integrity?
- 4. Do you share the indignation of the sons of Jacob when you become aware of assault on women, or similar types of sinful activity? Why was their plan right in some ways and wrong in other ways? How does their sense of justice contrast with Jacob's reluctance to become involved?
- 5. What happens to a culture that rejects the physical and biological differences between men and women? Are women more safe and more liberated when such differences are ignored? How does the biblical teaching about the roles of men and women affirm the value of both and enable each to complement the other?
